




Little Bibi flowers almost all year, is easy to grow and thrives with minimal water once established. It's also great to pick, as the flowers last well in a vase.. It likes full sun and can be left to grow naturally (as the ones at the hall have been) or pruned for a more formal look. If you have a sunny, well drained spot in your garden you might like to try planting Little Bibi, Alternately it grows well in containers and would brighten up a courtyard or sunny verandah.
